Purpose

Stop, Start, Continue, is often used by Scrum teams as a retrospective technique but can very easily be applied to help you identify areas of focus in your role transition.

| Framework name: | STOP, START, CONTINUE |
|------------------------|--|
| Participants: | Individuals or teams seeking action-oriented improvement ideas |
| Framework goal: | Identify opportunities for improvement and growth by evaluating actions that should be stopped, started, or continued. |
| Framework guidelines: | Consider what to stop, start, or continue, how to do so, and who can help support you in those actions. Consider ideas that MUST, SHOULD, or COULD be done Identify experiments that can be undertaken |
| Boundaries provided: | Break down actions such that they are specific and small enough to be completed within a month or less. |
| Resources used: | Tool to document actions, start/end dates, and learnings |
| Actionable outcome(s): | Backlog of personal improvements |
